

Middlestone Moor Primary School - Drop off and Pick up Reminders



Dear parents / carers,

Thank you to everyone who is supporting the safety of our school community by following our drop off and pick up times and following the one way system around school to avoid congestion both on the school site and on Rock Road.

There are just a few reminders and updates:-

- Please remember that no cars are allowed to enter the school or Nursery car park at any time, but especially not during drop off and pick up times. Mr Illingworth will be putting cones across the car park entrances as a reminder but parents can walk through the cones as this allows for better social distancing.
- Following a few near misses we need to ask that children don't ride their scooters/bikes/balance bikes on the school site– this includes the Nursery car park and the school yards. This is proving just too dangerous for the babies and toddlers we have on site.
- The car park beside Rainbow Nursery is their own private car park and can not be used by parents of our school and Nursery. (Please see letter overleaf from Rainbow Nursery).
- The only classes who can exit school back through our Nursery gates are Mrs Bowden's class and Mr Greenfield's class. Their pick up time is 3.20pm. However to avoid congestion on the Rock Road footpath next to school, we are asking that parents only exit this way if they are turning right towards Whitworth or crossing over to Central Drive.
