Information Regarding Children in Attendance at School

Dear parent,

We may not be able to answer all your questions at this point, but we hope this helps.

- The school day will run from **8.45am to 3.10pm**. Lunch time will be 12 noon till 1pm.
- Please drop your child off and collect at the entrance door they have been using this year. Please enter via the Nursery gate as usual.

Please note:

- ⇒ Mrs Howe's class will enter and exit school via the KS 1 door with Mrs Porthouse's children.
- ⇒ Miss Luke's class will enter and exit via the KS2 yard door with Mrs Jackson's class.

Please drop off and collect promptly at 8.45am and 3.10pm. As always you will need to inform school staff if someone different is collecting your child. Please continue to observe all covid safety measures on site and wear a mask.

- We would like the children to wear **school uniform** as this reminds them that this is school and not childcare provision.

Lunches

Children can bring their own packed lunches if they wish. School will provide the option of a hot meal if requested but this will be one option only each day and not the usual school menu choices.

Children entitled to free school meals and children in Reception and Key Stage 1 do not need to pay for their school meals. Other children should be paid for through ParentPay.

If you would like a meal provided through school and have not already told us this– please let school know before 9.30am tomorrow(Weds 6th Jan).

Please can all parents complete the Key Worker Information Sheet which we will send home with your child tomorrow. Please return this on Thursday showing the sessions you require for the **week beginning 11th January**. (Don't worry if your shifts and times change as we will support this). We will send the sheet home each week, but you can always ring school. Your child can be in school for half a day if you wish.

If you have any other queries, please ring or email school and we will do our best to answer as soon as possible.
