Information Regarding Remote Learning

Dear parent,

- Remote learning will start for your child (via TEAMS) on Wednesday Jan 6th.
- A timetable showing your child's meeting times with the teacher will be on the class page on the school website by tonight.

Please remember:-

- ⇒ Your child does not have to attend every online meeting but is expected to engage in the learning tasks set for them.
- ⇒ We understand if your home circumstances prevent your child attending all their meetings. It also may be that siblings may have to share devices and alternate accessing teacher meetings.
- ⇒ We will do our best to provide an online device for your child to borrow if they need one. If you have requested this, we will contact you tomorrow to confirm this. At present our supply of devices is limited so we need to allocate them in priority of need.
- ⇒ All classes have a resource pack available to be collected from the school lobby this week. This is not a pack of home learning work sheets. It is resources to help your child over the next few weeks. It may however contain some learning activities for your child to complete if they have free time.
- ⇒ We are dedicated to the learning and progress of all our children and will therefore be monitoring their engagement with their learning tasks. This is not to be "Big Brother" but to prevent children falling behind. We also know that contact with the teacher is very important for the children's well-being.
- ⇒ Parents can email teachers regarding queries related to learning or TEAMS. Any other queries, please ring the school office or send an email and we will do our best to answer as soon as possible.
- ⇒ As time progresses we will try to send any useful guidance and information to support parents in this at home. We are trying currently to get TEAMS guidance for parents and hope to soon offer some TEAMS training on zoom for any parent interested.

We will really miss our children and do everything we can to support them during this lockdown.
